In 2001, Liz and I were blessed to accompany Fr. Mike Scanlan on a pilgrimage through France, Belgium to shrines of the Blessed Virgin Mary. What a delightful trip that one was! We went to a small shrine in Belgium called Our Lady of All Nations. It was approved several times by the local bishops as private revelation of a woman named Ida Peerdeman from 1945-1959. It made a lasting impression upon me for some reason, and since January this year I have been led to pray the prayer every day. It seems to me that the prayer is certainly applicable at this time of Covid and civil disruptions in a particular way. It invokes the Lord to send the Spirit upon the entire world in order to preserve us from degeneration, disaster and war asking Mary to be our advocate under a new title "the Lady of All Nations."
